And whereas it is provided by section ten of the Tramways Amendment Act, 1910, that the license may be for such term not exceeding twenty-one years as the Governor in Council

And whereas William Pascoe, of Spreydon, in the Provincial District of Canterbury, has made application to the Inangahua County Council for a license to lay down, con-struct, and maintain the private tramway described in the Schedule hereto:
