BOROUGH OF INVERCARGILL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE PASSED AT A MEETING HELD ON THE 1ST DAY OF APRIL, 1915.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and the amendments thereof, the Borough of Invercargill hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of five thousand five hundred pounds (£5,500), authorized to be raised by the Borough of Invereargill, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of paying off the loans of £3,000 and £2,500 of the previously existing Borough of East Invereargill now part of the Borough of Invereargill, which fell due on the first day of January, 1915, the said Borough of Invereargill hereby makes and levies a special rate of 13d. (one penny three-farthings) upon all the rateable property within that part of the said Borough of Invereargill which immediately before union with the adjoining borough was the Borough of East Invereargill; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of May in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twelve years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
