## ORDER IN CCUNCIL.

THE RIGHT HONOURABLE W. F. MASSEY, P.C., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Napursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby direct that a poll shall be taken on the proposal that the area described in the Schedule hereto may be constituted a borough under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908; and, further, doth hereby make the following appointments and arrangements for the purpose of taking the said poll:—

1. Walter Waters, of Paeroa, to be the Returning Officer for the purpose of taking the said poll and lead to be the

for the purpose of taking the said poll, and also to be the person authorized to prepare a voters roll of the persons entitled to vote at the said poll.

2. The voters roll prepared and signed by the said Walter Waters shall be the voters roll to be used at the said poll.

3. Each person on such roll shall have and may exercise

one vote, and no more.
4. The said poll shall be taken on Thursday, the twentieth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and shall close at six o'clock in the afternoon of that day.

5. Except as herein provided, the said poll shall be taken as nearly as may be in the manner provided by the Local Elections and Polls Act, 1908, and the Returning Officer hereby appointed shall be deemed to be a Returning Officer appointed for the purposes of that Act.

### SCHEDULE.

Area proposed to be constituted the Borough of PAEROA.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Waihou River in line with the south-western boundary of Rau-o-te-huia No. 2 Block, in Block XII, Waihou Survey District; thence to and along the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of that block and the southern and north-eastern boundaries of Rau-o-te-haia Block to Tawa Stream, along the left bank of that stream and the north-eastern boundary of Part D of Taiwhakarewakauri Block to the Paeroa-Thames Road, across that road to the south-western corner of Taiwhakarewakauri A Block and along the south-western boundary of that block to a point distant 1360 links from its south-eastern corner; thence along a right line to a point on the southern boundary of that part of the eastern portion of Hararahi No. l Block, shown on Land Transfer Plan No. 2720A, distant 27 chains from the Pacroa-Thames Road; thence westerly along the said southern boundary for a distance of 940 links thence along a right line to a point on the northern side of the road forming the northern boundary of Aorangi Block, distant 850 links from the south-eastern corner of Te Arero-ohuatata No. 2 Block, across that road to the north-western corner of Aorangi B Block, along the western and southern boundaries of that block, the southern boundaries of Aorangi C and D Blocks, by the eastern boundary of Te Puru-o-te-rangi No. 2 Block, crossing the rifle range to Te Huruhuru No. 2A Block; thence along the northern and north-western boundaries of that block and the north-western boundaries of that block and the north-western boundary of Te Huruhuru No. 2c Block, and that boundary produced to the middle of a public road; thence along the middle of the road forming the north-eastern boundaries of Te Huruhuru No. 2D and Pukerimu No. 2 Blocks to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of the latter block; thence to and along eastern boundary of the latter block; thence to and along the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned block and its production to the middle of the Ohinemuri River, and along the middle of that river to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of parts of Ikutaratara and Muraoteahi Blocks, shown on plan number 2031, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland; thence along a right line to and by that boundary and its production to the Paeroa-Waihi Railway Reserve, and by that railway reserve to the northern boundary of Papaturoa Block; thence across the railway reserve and along the northern boundary of the said Papaturoa Block and its production to the middle of the Ohinemuri River; thence northerly along the middle of the Ohinemuri River; thence northerly along the middle of that river to a point in line with the middle of the proposed new cut, known as Pereniki's; thence to and along the middle of the said proposed new cut and its continuation to

the middle of the Ohinemuri River; and thence again northerly along the middle of that river and the Waihou River to the place of commencement.
