In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and all other Acts in that behalf enabling it, the Wairoa Borough Council hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and sinking fund and other charges on a loan of four thousand pounds (£4,000), authorized to be raised by the Borough, under the above-mentioned Acts, for the following purposes:—

To complete the installation of the present electric light

and power plant;
To install and house a larger storage battery;
To extend the service to the Wairoa Hospital and to certain other streets;

To build an Engineer's residence;
To provide the necessary stores, spares, and tools for the efficient working of the plant-

the said Wairoa Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one halfpenny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Wairoa. And that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan

is fully paid off.
