

Revoking Part of a Proclamation taking Land for a Further Portion of the North Auckland Railway (Huarau and Paparewa Sections), and for Road Approaches thereto.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, it is enacted that if at any time after the issue or making of any Proclamation taking land under the Public Works Act, 1908, and before the payment or award of any compensation in respect of the taking thereof, it is found that the land or any part thereof is not required for the purpose for which it was taken, or that any error in form or substance exists in or in relation to that Proclamation, or the making or gazetting thereof, the Governor may, by a subsequent Proclamation gazetted, revoke the former Proclamation either wholly or so far as he thinks necessary:

And whereas it is found that the Proclamation taking land for a further portion of the North Auckland Railway (Huarau and Paparewa Sections) and for road approaches thereto, made under the Public Works Act, 1908, dated the twenty-sixth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation"), and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 69, page 1878, of the twenty-seventh day of the same month, contains errors in the making or gazetting thereof:

And whereas compensation in respect of the taking of the said land has not been paid or awarded:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby revoke so much of the said Proclamation as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.

Stopping a Government Road in Blocks III and VII, Heao Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by paragraph (c) of section one hundred and thirty-three of the Public Works Act, 1908, it is enacted that the Governor may, by Proclamation publicly notified, stop or alter the course of any Government road or any part thereof:

And whereas the Government road described in the Schedule hereto is no longer required for the purpose of a road:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the above-in-part-recited Act, and of all other powers in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim as stopped the road described in the Schedule hereto.

- 1 acre 2 roods 14 perches, adjoining or passing through Koiro Block No. 5c. Situated in Blocks III and VII.
- 1 acre 3 roods 15 perches, adjoining or passing through Koiro Block No. 4b. Situated in Block III.
- 13 acres 1 rood 11 perches, adjoining or passing through Koiro Block No. 4e. Situated in Blocks III and VII.
- 9 perches, adjoining or passing through Crown land. Situated in Block VII.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section ninety-six of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913, it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time by Order in Council declare that any land subject to Part XIV or XV of the Native Land Act, 1909, and vested in a Maori Land Board, shall no longer be subject to such Parts of that Act, and shall be re-vested in the Native owners thereof:
