

Proclaiming Unclaimed Lands in Auckland Land District to be Crown Lands.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section twenty-nine of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies' Empowering Act, 1914, it is enacted that after not less than three months notice in the *Gazette*, and in such newspapers as he thinks fit, of his intention so to do, the Governor may declare that the lands referred to therein, or any portion of those lands, shall, from a date to be specified in the said Proclamation, be deemed to be Crown lands available for disposal under the Land Act, 1908:

And whereas the prescribed notice has been given in the *Gazette* and in newspapers:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section twenty-nine of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies' Empowering Act, 1914, do hereby proclaim and declare that the lands enumerated in the Schedule hereto (being portion of the lands referred to in the said section twenty-nine) shall, from and after the date of the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, be deemed to be Crown lands available for disposal under the Land Act, 1908.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section three hundred and seventy-four of the Native Land Act, 1909 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), and by section fourteen of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1914, it is provided, *inter alia*, that, on being satisfied that the purchase of any Native land has been duly completed by or on behalf of the Crown under the authority of the said Act, the Governor may issue a Proclamation that such land has become Crown land:

And whereas the purchase of the Native land set out in the Schedule hereto has been duly completed by or on behalf of the Crown under the authority of the said Act:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section three hundred and seventy-four of the said Act, and by section fourteen of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1914, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the land set out in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land.
