ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this eighteenth day of September, 1916.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, 1913, as extended by section twenty-four of the Regulation of Trade and Commerce Act, 1914, it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time by Order in Council prohibit the exportation of any goods the prohibition of the exportation of which is in his opinion necessary in the public interest:

And whereas by Order in Council made and gazetted on the tenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, the exportation of various goods was prohibited :

And whereas by Order in Council made and gazetted on the twentyfourth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, the aforesaid Order in Council of the tenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, was amended :

And whereas it is now deemed expedient to revoke the said Order in Council of the twenty-fourth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and to amend the said Order in Council of the tenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, 1913, and section twenty-four of the Regulation of Trade and Commerce Act, 1914, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of that Dominion, doth hereby revoke the aforesaid Order in Council of the twenty-fourth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and doth hereby amend the aforesaid Order in Council of the tenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, in manner follow-ing:—
