The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 748, as against 571 in September—an increase of 177. The deaths in October were 286—a decrease of 25 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths males contributed 155, females 131. Fitty-seven of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 19.93 per cent. of the whole number; 35 of these were under one year of age. There were 107 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 117 in September. The following table shows the classification:—
