Defining the Middle-line of a Branch Railway from the East Coast Main Trunk Railway from a Point in Repongaere A Block to a Quarry in Section 79, Block IV, Patutahi Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS a branch railway from the East Coast Main Trunk Railway from a point in Repongaere A Block to a Quarry in Section 79, Block IV, Patutahi Survey District (hereinafter termed "the said railway"), is a railway the construction of which is authorized by the Railways Authorization Act, 1914: And whereas it has been determined to construct and maintain the said railway:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section one hundred and eighty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1908, and in exercise of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of the said railway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.

COMMENCING at a Point at Repongaere Station in Repongaere A Block, Block IV, Patutahi Survey District, marked 0 miles, and proceeding thence generally in a southerly
