WHEREAS by the Public Works Act, 1908, it is in section fifteen thereof, *inter alia*, enacted that, except for the purpose of a railway or defence purposes, or for the purposes of any other work to be made under the authority of a special Act, nothing in this Act contained shall authorize the taking of any land occupied by any building, yard, garden, ornamental park, or pleasure-ground, without the previous consent of the Governor in Council:

And whereas part of the land described in the Schedule hereto is occupied by fruit-trees, and the Education Board of the Education District of Auckland has applied for the consent of the Governor in Council to the taking of the said land for the purposes of a school, and it is expedient that such consent should be given:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the above-mentioned Act, and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby consent to the land described in the Schedule hereto being taken for the purposes above named.
