WHEREAS by section forty-seven of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908 (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, appoint any local authority to be a Domain Board having, subject to the said Act, control of any public domain:

And whereas by an Order in Council made on the twentieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, of the twenty-sixth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and eight, a Domain Board was appointed to control the Dorie Domain:

And whereas the period for which the said Board was appointed expired on the nineteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen:

And whereas it appears expedient to again appoint a Domain Board to control the domain:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby appoint the
