The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 597, against 641 in November—a decrease of 44. The deaths in December were 291—an increase of 70 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths males contributed 154, females 137. Sixty-two of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 21.31 per cent. of the whole number; 25 of these were under one year of age.

There were 110 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 79 in November. The following table shows the classification:—
