ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this twenty-second day of February, 1916.

Present :

IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the National Provident Fund Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend and supplement in the manner hereinafter set forth the regulations made under the said Act on the ninth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and published in the *Gazette* of the nineteenth day of the same month, and also the regulations made on the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, and published in the *Gazette* of the fourth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twelve.

REGULATION.

INCAPACITY BENEFIT.

1. THE form F of the regulations hereinbefore referred to is hereby revoked, and form F in the First Schedule hereto is substituted therefor.

The Board may require a medical certificate to be furnished at such time or times as may be decided in each case.

CHILDREN'S ALLOWANCE.

2. The application for this benefit shall be on form G hereof, and shall be supported by a declaration in form H.

WARRANT APPOINTING AN AGENT.

3. Applications to appoint any person to act as an agent for the receipt of allowances due on behalf of any incapacitated beneficiary must be made in the form I.

The person in whose favour the warrant is to be issued must be a reputable person, and must record his assent to act on the application form.
