RESOLUTION MAKING AND LEVYING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Whangamomona County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of one thousand five hundred pounds (£1,500), authorized to be raised by the Whangamomona County Council, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for forming, culverting, and metalling the Putikituna Road from the Tangarakau River to the junction of the Kohuratahi Road, or for so far as the loan-money will go in conjunction with a £1-for-£1 subsidy, the said Whangamomona County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of twopence and three-farthings in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Putikituna Road £1,500 Loan Special-rating Area, comprising Sections 15, 16, 17, Block XV; Section 4, Block XIV, of the Pouatu Survey District, and Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, Block III, and Sections 8 and 9, Block II, of the Mahoe Survey District. And that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first day of January and the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
