Revoking a Proclamation taking Land for the Purpose of Waterworks in Block XVI, Christchurch Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, it is enacted that if at any time after the issue or making of any Proclamation taking land under the Public Works Act, 1908, and before the payment or award of any compensation in respect of the taking thereof, it is found that the land or any part thereof is not required for the purpose for which it was taken, or that any error in form or substance exists in or in relation to that Proclamation or the making or gazetting thereof, the Governor may, by a subsequent Proclamation gazetted, revoke the former Proclamation, either wholly or in so far as he thinks necessary:

And whereas it is found that the land, being portion of R.S. 122, Block XVI, Christchurch Survey District, taken for the purposes of waterworks by a Proclamation made under the Public Works Act, 1908, and dated the twenty-third day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation"), and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 80, page 3265, of the thirtieth day of the same month, is no longer required for the purpose for which it was taken: And whereas compensation in respect of the land taken by the said Proclamation has not been paid or awarded:
