Prohibiting the Exportation of Hides and Calf-skins.

LIVERPOOL, Governor. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this twenty-ninth day of March, 1916.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, 1913, as extended by section twenty-four of the Regulation of Trade and Commerce Act, 1914, it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, prohibit the exportation of any goods the prohibition of the exportation of which is in his opinion necessary in the public interest:

And whereas by Order in Council made on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and gazetted on the sixth day of the same month, in pursuance of the said Acts, the exportation of

various goods was prohibited:

And whereas it is now deemed expedient to amend the aforesaid

Order in Council in the manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, 1913, and section twenty-four of the Regulation of Trade and Commerce Act, 1914, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of that Dominion, doth hereby—

(1.) Amend the aforesaid Order in Council of the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, by omitting the words "hides" and "calf-skins" from the Fifth Schedule thereto, which contains a list of goods the exportation of which to any destination other than the United Kingdom and British Possessions and Protectorates is prohibited:

(2.) Prohibit the exportation of the following articles—namely, hides weighing less than forty-five pounds each and calfskins, to any destination other than the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth of Australia, except with the

consent of the Minister of Customs:

(3.) In all respects confirm the Order in Council of the second day of February, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, published in the New Zealand Gazette of the third day of the same month, prohibiting the exportation of hides weighing forty-five pounds each or over to any destination except with the consent of the Minister of Customs.
