

Authorizing the Sale of Part of Allotment 170, Oruawhoro Parish, under Section 21 of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act, 1915.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section twenty-one of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act, 1915, it is provided that the Governor, by Proclamation, may authorize the trustees of the Port Albert Agricultural Show-ground to sell by public auction the land described in the Schedule hereto on such terms and conditions as he deems fit: And whereas it is desired to sell the said land by public auction at Messrs. A. Buckland and Sons' Saleyards at Welsford, at the upset price of thirty-five pounds:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority conferred upon me by section twenty-one of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies' Empowering Act, 1915, and all other powers and authorities enabling me in that behalf, hereby declare that the said lands may be sold by public auction at the saleyards of Messrs. Buckland and Sons at Welsford, on a date to be fixed by the trustees; and hereby proclaim and declare that prior to the sale of the said land due notice of intention to sell shall be advertised in one newspaper circulating in the district, and due notice of sale as aforesaid shall be given for at least fourteen days prior to the date of the sale.
