THE Auckland Harbour Board have notified that a permanent trig. station has been erected on the reef of Judges Bay, in connection with the new railway works.

The trig. station is situated 160 ft. inside or to the southward of the extreme end of the reef, and takes the form of a triangular structure with a flagpole in the centre.

Two temporary line beacons have been erected by the Railway Department in Hobson Bay on a line bearing 137° 44′ (S. 58° 46′ E. magnetic) from the permanent trig. station. The first of these beacons is situated 3.9 cables from the trig. station, and the second 6.5 cables from the trig. station.
