RESOLUTION

THE following regulations were laid before the members of the Stratford Racing Club at a meeting held on the 17th day f November, 1915, at Stratford, with a recommendation by the Chairman of the Club, Mr. W. H. H. Young, that the same be passed at once with a view to their approval by the Governor, in pursuance of the Gaming Act, 1908,

Mr. W. J. Morrison, the Vice-chairman of the Club and the chairman of the meeting, moved, and Mr. W. P. Kirkwood seconded, and it was resolved, That such regulations should be adopted, and that the Chairman be authorized to sign the same in authentication thereof.

The following are the regulations referred to:-

STRATFORD RACING CLUB. REGULATIONS.

(Under the Gaming Act, 1908.)

In pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in section 33 of the Gaming Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities it enabling in that benail, the Sulandian Racing Club, a racing club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said club"), doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admission of persons to that part of the club's property situate in the District of Taranaki, and known as the Stratford Racecourse, while the said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club powers and authorities it enabling in that behalf, the Stratford while the said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club for race meetings.

1. In these regulations the words "bookmaker," "racing club," and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms by section 2 of the Gaming Act, 1908.

2. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the racecourse above described while the same is used or occupied by the said club for a race meeting, namely:

(a.) Bookmakers.

(a.) Bookmakers.
(b.) All persons under disqualification inflicted by any racing club in the Dominion of New Zealand, the Commonwealth of Australia, or elsewhere, if affiliated to the Racing Conference of New Zealand.
(c.) Common prostitutes, and persons who habitually consort with thieves or with persons who have no lawful visible means of support.

The foregoing regulations of the Stratford Racing Club were made and passed by the club on the 17th day of November, 1915, and signed by the Acting-Chairman and Secretary.
