

"4. That part of Tihioanono Block be leased to Ngatai Hooper, of Te Araroa, for a term of twenty-one years at a rental of 4s. per acre per annum or 5 per centum of the present Government valuation; whichever is the greater, together with the right to a renewal for a further term of twenty-one years at a rental equal to 5 per centum per annum of the then Government unimproved valuation of the said land, or with the right to compensation for improvements.

"5. That a portion of Tihioanono Block be leased to Henare Pereto, farmer, of Taumataomanu, for a term of twenty-one years at a rental equal to 5 per centum per annum of the present Government valuation of the said land, together with the right to a renewal for a further term of twenty-one years at a rental equal to 5 per centum per annum on the then Government unimproved valuation of the said land, or with the right to compensation for improvements should the lease be not renewed."
