A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is required to be taken, under the Public Works Act, 1908, for certain public works—to wit, for the purposes of a road and for harbour purposes in Blocks IV and IVa, Tokomaru Survey District, Waiapu County:

And whereas the Waiapu County Council has laid before the Governor a memorial, accompanied by a map in duplicate, and also the statutory declaration, as required by the said Act:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and the Counties Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land firstly described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a road, and shall vest in His Majesty the King, and that the land secondly described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for harbour purposes, and shall vest in the Corporation of the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Waiapu; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the eighth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
