IN pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section four of the Discharged Soldiers Settle-ment Act, 1915, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile; Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the areas of Crown land described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same are her by set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or lease to discharged soldiers, under special tenures, in the manner provided in the said Act. the manner provided in the said Act.

Wainui has, by resolution adopted at an ordinary meeting thereof, requested that the name of the locality situated in the Road District of Akaroa-Wainui and known as "German Bay" be altered to "Takamatua": Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by the Designation of Districts Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New. Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the name of the locality now known as "German Bay" shall be and the same is hereby altered to "Takamatua," and do assign the last-mentioned name to such locality accordingly; and the last-mentioned name to such locality accordingly; and also do hereby proclaim and declare that the name of the bay now known as "German Bay" shall be and the same is hereby altered to "Takamatua Bay," and do assign the last-mentioned name to such bay accordingly; and also do hereby proclaim and declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the first day of November, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, not being earlier than six months after the first publication thereof in the *Gazette*.
