REGULATION No. 52.

THE Maori Land Board for the Tairawhiti Maori Land District hereby notifies that a meeting of the owners of Tutaekuri No. 1A Block is summoned and will be held, in pursuance of Part XVIII of the Native Land Act, 1909, at Wairoa on Wednesday, the 16th day of August, 1916, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of considering the following proposed resolution:—

“That the Tutaekuri No. 1A Block be leased to Tamihana Karari, one of the owners, for a term of twenty-one years at an annual rental equivalent to £5 per centum of the Government valuation for the said block, payable half-yearly in advance, such lease to contain the covenants usually inserted in leases of a like nature from the Board.”
