NO. 11 SPECIAL-RATING AREA.—WAINUIOMATA BRIDGE.—RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE IN RESPECT OF 10 PER CENT. ADDITIONAL ON LOAN OF £500.

In the matter of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and its amendments, and regulations thereunder.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Hutt County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of fifty pounds (£50), ten pounds per centum on loan of five hundred pounds (£500), authorized to be raised by the Hutt County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of constructing and erecting a bridge across the Wainuiomata River on the Wainuiomata Road, the said Hutt County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one one-hundred-and-fortieth of a penny (1/140th) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the No. 11 Special-rating Area (Wainuiomata Bridge) comprising the lands in the said special-rating area, being the several sections and blocks hereinafter enumerated, that is to say:—
