

COOK COUNTY COUNCIL.

SPECIAL RESOLUTION MADE ON THE TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1916.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Cook County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £1,000, authorized to be raised by the Cook County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for constructing a part of the Tokonui Road, the said Cook County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two-fifths of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Tokonui Number 2 Special-rating District, comprising Puninga 4B 2, Puninga 4B 1, Puninga 5, Puninga 3A 3B, Puninga 4A, part Small Grazing-run 40 (3,770 acres), part Section 3, Block X, all in the Nuhaka North Survey District; part Section 3, Maraetaha 2; Section 2, Block III, Nuhaka North Survey District; Maraetaha 2c; Sections 2 and 3, Blocks II and III, Nuhaka North Survey District. And that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during a period equal to the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off. The rate of interest to be four and a half per cent.
