Revoking a Proclamation taking Land for the Purposes of a Road in Block XIII, Ohinewairua Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, it is enacted that if at any time after the issue or making of any Proclamation taking land under the Public Works Act, 1908, and before the payment or award of any compensation in respect of the taking thereof, it is found that the land, or any part thereof, is not required for the purpose for which it was taken, or that any error in form or substance exists in or in relation to that Proclamation or the making of gazetting thereof, the Governor may, by a subsequent Proclamation gazetted, revoke the former Proclamation, either wholly or in so far as he thinks necessary:

And whereas it is found that the land, being portion of Section 26, Block XIII, Ohinewairua Survey District, taken for the purposes of a road by a Proclamation made under the Public Works Act, 1908, and dated the second day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation"), and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 124, pages 3688 and 3689, of the fourth day of the same month, is no longer required for the purpose for which it was taken: And whereas compensation in respect of the land taken by the said Proclamation has not been paid or awarded:
