IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portion of road described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become a county road.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that portion of the Waitewhena Road, in the Taranaki Land District, Waitomo County, commencing at the north-western corner of Section 8, Block VI, Aria Survey District, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction generally, adjoining or passing through Sections 7, 6, and 12 (scenery reserve) 2, Block VI, and Sections 6 and 16 (scenery reserve), Block II, to its junction with the Kiekie Road; being a distance of three miles and a half, more or less. IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portions of roads described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become county roads.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that portion of road, in the Auckland Land District, Waitemata County, known as Sunnyside Road, commencing at the south-western corner of Section 208, Paremoremo Parish, and proceeding in an easterly and north-easterly direction generally, adjoining or passing through Sections 208, 209, 67, 236, 237, 239, 240, 234, 241, 242, 243, Paremoremo Parish, Block VI, Waitemata Survey District, and terminating at the southern boundary of Section 81, Paremoremo Parish, in the said Block VI, Waitemata Survey District; being a distance of 1 mile 45 chains, more or less, and marked A B L.
