The following classes of deaf children are admitted to the School for the Deaf (sound intellect being always a necessity) :-

- Children born deaf, or who have lost their hearing before learning to speak.
  Children who can hear a little, but are too deaf to
- be taught in a public school.
- 3. Children who have lost their hearing after having learned to speak.

The Act imposes upon every parent, teacher of a school (either public or private), constable, or officer of a chari-table or kindred institution who is aware of the place of residence (either temporary or permanent) of a deaf child, and the householder in whose house any such child resides, an obligation to send notification of the fact to the **Minister of Education, giving the name, age, and address** of the child; and any neglect or failure to comply with this provision involves liability to a fine.
