*Storage.*

Storage will be charged on all import goods or merchandise not taken away within twelve working-hours, per s. d.  
ton, per day or fraction thereof .. .. 1 0  
On all export goods or merchandise if not shipped per first steamer for which they are consigned, storage, per ton, per day or fraction thereof .. 0 6  
On wool, flax, tow, sheep-skins, and rabbit-skins, per bale, per day or fraction thereof .. 0 3  
On tallow, per cask, per day or fraction thereof .. 0 3  
On timber remaining over sixty-four working-hours, per 100 superficial feet, per week .. 0 2

The working-hours are from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on week-days. The above storage charges do not include handling.

Flax and tow delivered at Maunganui Station to await shipment will be charged 6d. per bale, which will include receiving into shed, loading up, and delivery to ships in trucks alongside wharf.
