That the said land be leased to Coral Amelia Davey, wife of Albert Edward Davey, of Hiruharama, for the term of forty-two years, at a rental of 5 per cent. on the Government valuation thereof for the first twenty-one years, and at a rental of 5 per cent. on the unimproved Government valuation for the remaining twenty-one years of the said term (Treadwell, Gordon, and Brodie).
