Revoking Part of a Proclamation taking Land for a Further Portion of the Stratford-Kawakawa Railway (Pohokura Section), and for Road-diversions in connection therewith.

 A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, it is enacted that if at any time after the issue or making of any Proclamation taking land under the Public Works Act, 1908, and before the payment or award of any compensation in respect of the taking thereof, it is found that the land or any part thereof is not required for the purpose for which it was taken, or that any error in form or substance exists in or in relation to that Proclamation or the making or gazetting thereof, the Governor-General may, by a subsequent Proclamation gazetted, revoke the former Proclamation, either wholly or so far as he thinks necessary:

And whereas it is found that portions of the land taken for a further portion of the Stratford-Kawakawa Railway (Pohokura Section), and for road-diversions in connection therewith, by a Proclamation made under the Public Works Act, 1908, dated the twenty-second day of September, one thousand nine hundred and eleven (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation") and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 77, pages 2906 and 2907, of the twenty-eighth day of the same month, are not now required for the purpose for which they were taken:

And whereas compensation in respect of the taking of the said land has not been paid or awarded:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby revoke so much of the said Proclamation as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.

Amending General Harbour Regulations.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section two hundred and five of the Harbours Act, 1908, it is enacted that the Governor-General in Council may from time to time make regulations, to be called "General Harbour Regulations," which shall be in force in all ports of New Zealand for the purposes set forth therein:

And whereas by Order in Council dated the fifth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the seventh day of the same month, General Harbour Regulations were made:

And whereas it is advisable to revoke clause eight of the said regulations of the fifth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, and to make a new regulation in lieu thereof:
