The master or owner of every ship in any harbour shall at all times keep on board a sufficient number of men to perform any services required for the safety of such ship, and, unless he has obtained a written exemption from the Harbourmaster, he shall at all times, as well by day as by night, have at least one seaman in charge of the deck of such ship; and the seaman having such charge, and all persons having the charge of or being on board of any ship or boat within any harbour, shall answer to the challenge of the Harbourmaster, water police, or other duly authorized public officer. Any master or person in charge of any ship or boat who shall offend against this regulation shall be liable to a penalty.
