A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, it is enacted that if at any time after the issue or making of any Proclamation taking land under the Public Works Act, 1908, and before the payment or award of any compensation in respect of the taking thereof, it is found that the land or any part thereof is not required for the purpose for which it was taken, or that any error in form or substance exists in or in relation to that Proclamation or the making or gazetting thereof, the Governor-General may, by a subsequent Proclamation gazetted, revoke the former Proclamation, either wholly or so far as he thinks necessary: And whereas it is found that portion of the land taken for a further portion of the Otago Central Railway, portion of Cromwell Section, by a Proclamation made under the Public Works Act, 1908, dated the sixteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation"), and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 142, page 3885, of the twenty-first day of the same month, is not now required for the purpose for which it was taken:
