HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL. WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the twenty-third day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the twenty-sixth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, rates of postage were fixed under the authority of the Post and Telegraph Act, 1008 (herein-after termed " the said Act "), for the transmission (*inter alia*) of parcels through the post within the Dominion of New Zealand : And whereas it is desirable to amend such rates of postage in the manner hereinafter set forth : Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Excettive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke so much of the Schedule to the aforesaid Order in Council as prescribes the rates of postage on parcels addressed to any destina-tion within New Zealand, and in lieu thereof doth make and fix the rates of postage set forth in the Schedule hereto ; and doth further order and deelare that such rates of postage shall come into force on the fifteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, and that this Order shall form part of and be read with the said Order in Council dated the twenty-third day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen. hundred and fourteen.
