Crown Land set apart for Disposal by Way of Sale or Lease to Discharged Soldiers, under Special Tenures, in the Auckland Land District.

LIVERPOOL, Governor-General. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section four of the Discharged Soldiers Settle-ment Act, 1915, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the area of Crown land described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby set amart and declared one for disposel the same is hereby set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or lease to discharged soldiers, under special tenures, in the manner provided in the said Act.

AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT .- CROWN LAND.

SECTION 18, Block VI, Waoku Survey District: Area, 117 acres 3 roods 4 perches.

for selection under that section pursuant to Proclamation in that behalf :

SECTIONS 13, 14, and 17, Block IX, and Sections 9, 10, and 11, Block XIII, Hautapu Survey District: Area, 770 acres 1 rood 10 perches.
