**SOUTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.**

**CLUTHA.**

CLUTHA District comprises the existing Clutha Electoral District, less that part of the Toetoes Riding of Southland County lying to the east of the existing Mataura Electoral District boundary, and bounded on the east by a straight line from the said existing Mataura Electoral District boundary from the south-western corner of Section 13, Block X, Tutarau Survey District, to the north-eastern corner of Block III, Wyndham Survey District; thence by the said survey district boundary to the north-eastern corner of Block III, Toetoes Survey District; thence by that survey district boundary to the Tokanui River, and by that river to the bridge crossing the said river at Tokanui Township; thence by a road leaving the said bridge to and passing through Fortrose Township to Toetoes Harbour; thence by the eastern side of the said harbour to the ocean; together with that part of the Beaumont Riding of Tuapeka County now included in the Tuapeka Electoral District hereinbefore described, also the Clydevale Riding of Clutha County and the Matau Riding of Bruce County. This district also comprises Balclutha Borough, Tapanui Borough, the Borough of Kaitangata, and the Clinton Town District.
