EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS AT A MEETING HELD ON THE FIFTH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1917, AT 10 A.M.

pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by section 22 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Opotiki County Council hereby resolves as follows :

That, for the purpose of providing interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of four thousand pounds (£4,000) authorized to be raised by consent of the ratepayers under section 15 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and its amendments, for the purpose of the formation of the Waioeka amendments, for the purpose of the formation of the walocka River Main Road, and on a further supplementary loan of four hundred pounds ($\pounds400$) authorized to be raised by sec-tion 18 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for the purpose of the completion of the said work [being 10 per cent. addi-tional of the said loan of four thousand pounds ($\pounds4,000$)], the Oparthic County. Council hereby, increases the special rate of Opotiki County Council hereby increases the special rate of twopence in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Upper Waioeka Special-rating District made and levied by resolution passed on the 19th day of April, 1913, and gazetted in the New Zealand Gazette on the 8th day of May, 1913, at pages 1558 and 1559, to a special rate of three and one-sixteenth pence in the pound sterling on the rateable property in the said Upper Waioeka Special-rating District; and the said special rate shall be an annually recurring rate payable half-yearly on the 1st day of January and the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loans, being a period of thirty-six and one-half years, or until the said loans are fully paid off.

NEW BRIGHTON BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION BY WAY OF SPECIAL ORDER MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the New Brighton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows :— That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the New Brighton Borough Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for road-formation and kerbing and channelling of roads, Act, for road-formation and kerbing and channeling of roads, purchase of land for road purposes, planting for protection against sanddrift, and drainage, the said New Brighton Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixpence and one-eighth of a penny ($6\frac{1}{2}d$.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property included in the South New Brighton Loan Area, such area being in Block 1 of the Christehurch and Summer Survey District, described as follows:— Commencing at a point being the north-eastern corner of

Commencing at a point being the north-eastern corner of Lot 12, as shown on deposit plan 94; thence southerly along the Esplanade and the Esplanade Reserve to the southern boundary of Rural Section 23574; then westerly along the southern boundary of that rural section to the estuary of the River Avon: thence northerly generally along the said estuary and the River Avon and the old watercourse of the said river to Richmond Terrace, and across that road to the northern boundary of Lot 16. deposit plan 783; thence westerly along the northern boundary of Lot 76. deposit plan 783; there westerly along the northern boundary of Lots 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 of deposit plan 783 to the south-western boundary of Lot 7 of the same deposit plan; thence northerly along the said boundary to Rodney Street; thence across George Street to the south-western corner of Lot 27, as shown on demosit blan 04, there are the large the said sector acid deposit plan 94; thence northerly along the said eastern side of George Street to Hood Street; thence easterly along the southern boundary of Hood Street to the commencing-point.

WAIMAMAKU LOAN, £500.-Resolution making Special RATE.

N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Hokianga County Council hereby resolves as follows :

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of five hundred pounds, authorized to be raised by the Hokianga County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of preparing the formation

and metalling the Waimamaku Valley Road from the end of the metalling opposite Section 8, Block XIV, Waoku Survey District, to Powick's gate on Section 1, Block XV, Waoku Survey District, the said Hokianga County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven-farthings in the pound upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property

upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property within the following special-rating area, viz. :---All the portion of the Omapere Riding of the Hokianga County comprised within the northern boundaries of Sec-tions 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, Block IX, Waoku; the eastern boundary of Section 12 aforesaid; the southern boundaries of Sections 2 and 10, Block X, Waoku; a portion of the eastern boundary of Section 11; thence by the southern boundary of Section 12, a portion of the western boundary of Section 15, the northern boundary of that section; also the northern boundaries of Sections 14 and 18, Block XV; Waoku; the northern boundary of Section 1, Block XV; the eastern boundary of Section 21, and a portion of Section 1, Block XV; the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 22, Block XV; the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 22, Block XV, Waoku; the southern boundaries of Section 22 and 1, Block XV; and Sections 6 and 9, Block XIV, running in a line to the intersection of an extended line drawn parallel with the eastern boundary of Section 8, Block XIV aforesaid, and the southern boundary of Section 8, and a portion of the western boundary of the same section; thence by the southern boundaries of Sections 7, 10, 12, and 13, Block XIV; a portion of the western boundary of Section 13 aforesaid to the intersection of the southern boundary of Section 12, Block XIII: thence by the southern boundary of that sec-tion and the southern boundaries of Sections 7, 6, and 5, Block XIII: thence by the western boundaries of Sections 5, 2, and 1, Block XIII, Waoku: thence by the southern boundaries of Sections 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2, and the western boundary of the aforesaid Section 2, Block IX, to the starting-point.

And that such special rate shall be an annually recurring And that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of January and the 1st day of July in each and every year during the period of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
