### A PROCLAMATION.

DY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the State Forests Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalt, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby set apart the forest land described in the Schedule hereto, forming part of the Crown lands in New Zealand, as and for a State forest within the provisions of the said Act.

#### SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Nelson Land District, containing by estimation 1,310 acres, more or less, and situated in Blocks VI and X, Aorere Survey District.
