TIME-SIGNAL AT LYTTTELTON.

ON days when accurate time-signals are given, arrangements have been made to drop the Lyttelton Harbour Board's time-ball at Lyttelton at 3 h. 30 m. p.m. New Zealand mean time by direct signal from the Observatory, Wellington.

The signal is given at an exact hour of Greenwich mean time—i.e., at 16 h. G.M.T., which corresponds to 3 h. 30 m. p.m. of New Zealand mean time.

The time-signals will be sent on Tuesdays and Fridays, provided satisfactory observations have been obtained.

If time-signals are required on other days, or at other exact hours of Greenwich mean time, application for them should be made to the Observatory, Wellington.
