Vesting Exclusive Care and Control and Management of Portion of "Kawau Cut" Drain in the Palmerston North Borough Council.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Palmerston North Borough Council has made application for the issue of a Proclamation under section sixty-four of the Land Drainage Act, 1908, vesting the control of a certain portion of the drain known as the "Kawau Cut" in the Council:

And whereas it is expedient to issue the Proclamation as requested:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority vested in me by section sixty-four of the Land Drainage Act, 1908, do hereby proclaim and direct that that portion of the drain known as the "Kawau Cut" within the boundaries of the Borough of Palmerston North shall from and after the first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, be under the exclusive care, control, and management of the Palmerston North Borough Council.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Dominion, at the Government House at Wellington, this ten h day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.
