PASSPORTS.

VISAS AND SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

Visas.

THE Passpart, if for use in any of the following countries, must bear the *visa* of a Consular Officer of that country. The addresses in London to which application should be made are as follows:—

For other countries *visas* are not required, and are useful only as an additional precaution.

\* FRANCE.—Three days' notice must be given, and two additional photographs are required. Personal attendance is necessary, and the *visa* is valid only for departure within three days.

To visit any place within the Zone of the Armies a Permit is required from the Military Permit Office, 19, Bedford Square.

All visitors to France wishing to remain there for more than fifteen days must be furnished with a "Carte d'Identité." Application for this document must be made within forty-eight hours of arrival in the first locality in which the traveller desires to remain to the Prefect of the Department concerned.

Passengers from France must obtain the necessary *visa* for departure. In Paris the *visa* is obtained from the Permit Office, 18, Rue Chauveau Lagarde.

† RUSSIA.—In applying for the *visa* the religion of the applicant must be stated. The *visa* must be within six months of the date of entering Russia. A Russian Passport has to be taken out by British subjects in addition to their national Passport after they have been six months in Russia. To leave Russia a Police *visa* has to be obtained. To re-enter Russia the *visa* of a Russian Consul abroad is necessary.

‡ ROUMANIA.—Within twenty-four hours of arrival in Roumania the Passport should be *viséd* at His Majesty's Legation or at a British Consulate, and application made to the Roumanian Authorities for a Permit to reside. For a stay of
