- (g.) Ability to conduct experimental work in all branches of horticulture and make correct records of same:
- (h.) Familiarity with New Zealand climatic and soil conditions.

4. The successful applicant would be provided with a house, for which an annual rental at the rate of 10 per cent. of his salary would be charged.
