## LIVERPOOL, Governor.

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred on me by section seventy-three of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, do hereby direct that the Eltham County Council, Stratford County Council, Waimate West County Council, and Eltham Borough Council shall, in respect of the loans specified in the Schedule hereto, pay annually to the Hawera County Council, on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of the said loans, the respective amounts set out in column "G" of the said Schedule opposite to their names as their duly proportionate parts of the interest and other charges payable in respect of the said loans.
