Additional Lands at Maimai taken for the Purposes of the Stopping a Government Road in Block XII, Pirongia Survey Stillwater-Reefton Railway and Road-diversion in connection therewith.

LIVERPOOL, Governor. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Stillwater-Reefton Railway to take further land at Maimai, in addition to land
