A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the twenty-second day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twenty-eighth day of that month, certain lands in the Wellington Land District were declared to be reserves under the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908:

And whereas the land described in the Schedule hereto (being part of the lands so set apart) is no longer suitable for scenic purposes by reason of the destruction of the bush thereon:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on me by section eight of the Scenery Preservation Amendment Act, 1910, do hereby revoke the reservation for scenic purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, containing by admeasurement 3 roods 11 perches, more or less, being Section 10 (formerly portion of Section 5), Block III, Manganui Survey District. Bounded towards the north-west by Section 5, 250 links; towards the north-east by Retaruke Valley Road, 571.2 links; and towards the south-west generally by a public road one chain wide along the bank of the Retaruke River: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less. As the same is delineated on a plan marked L and S. 616/4, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
