##### RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL INTEREST RATE FOR SPECIAL LOAN OF £5,000.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Elstow Drainage Board hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £5,000, authorized to be raised by the Elstow Drainage Board, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of improving present watercourses and drains, and constructing new watercourses and drains in the Elstow Drainage District, the Elstow Drainage Board hereby makes and levies a special interest rate on a graduated scale according to the classification list of lands within the aforementioned Elstow Drainage District, of one penny farthing in the pound ( $\frac{1}{4}$ d. per £1) on the rateable value of all lands in class "A," one penny in the pound (1d. per £1) on the rateable value of all lands in class "B," and three-farthings in the pound ( $\frac{3}{4}$ d. per £1) on the rateable value of all lands in class "C," all of which classes, and the lands therein, together with their rateable values as appearing on the valuation roll of the district, are set out in the classification list (marked "A") of the Elstow Drainage District.

Such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first day of January and the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and one-half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
