seventeen, accordingly; and doth hereby declare that this Order in Council shall come into operation on the date of the publication thereof in the Gazette.

## SCHEDULE.

1. Clause 5 of the hereinbefore-recited Order in Council of the 5th day of February, 1917, is hereby revoked, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"5. This Order in Council shall not apply to a contract for the sale of machine-dressed seed-wheat, and shall not apply to a contract for the sale of any other seed-wheat, if such contract is made with the knowledge and appropriate the Record of Trade."

ledge and approval of the Board of Trade."

2. The maximum price per bushel in any month of machine-dressed wheat, sold as seed-wheat and intended to be used as such, shall be 1s. more than the maximum price per bushel, during that month, of wheat (not being seed-wheat, but otherwise of the same kind), sold on the same terms and conditious as to delivery and otherwise, as fixed by the hereinbefore-recited Order in Council of the 5th day of February, 1917.
