Amendment of the Regulations under the Public Service Act, 1912.

IN pursuance and exercise of the authority conferred on him by the Public Service Act, 1912 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the Commissioner, with the approval of the Governor-General in Council, doth hereby amend clause two hundred and nine of the regulations under the said Act, as made on the seventh day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and published in the *Gazette* of the eleventh day of January, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto. Such amendment shall have effect on the date of the publication thereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

SCHEDULE.

REGULATION No. 209 is hereby amended by adding the following proviso to the first paragraph thereof: "Provided that an officer occupying such higher position, but not in fact performing the whole of the duties of such position, shall be entitled only to such allowance in addition to salary as shall be determined by the Commissioner."
