

mencing at the Puwhenua Trig. Station (situated in Block VIII, Tapapa Survey District), by a right line running in the direction of Weraiti Trig. Station (situated in Block VII, Tapapa East Survey District) to its intersection with a right line running due west from Otane-Waimuku Trig. Station (in Block XVI, Otanewainuku Survey District); thence by that line to the last-mentioned trig. station, and that line produced to a point due south of Trig. Station II in Block IV, Waihi South Survey District; thence by a right line running due north through Trig. II aforesaid to the high-water mark to the Bay of Plenty; thence by the high-water mark of the sea to the western side of Maraetotara Road, in Block III, Whakatane Survey District; thence towards the east generally by the western side of that road to its junction with the Nukuhou-Maraetotara Road (Whakatane-Opotiki main road); thence along the western side of the last-mentioned road to its junction with the Nukuhou (Waimana-Ohiwa) Road; thence by the western side of that road to the confiscation-line; thence by part of the northern boundary-line of Waimana No. 1E Block, by the north-eastern and south-eastern boundary of Section 21, Block IV, Waimana Survey District, the south-eastern boundaries of Waimana 1c and 1d Blocks to Paitaua, and by the south-western boundary of the last-mentioned block to the Waimana or Tauranga River; thence by that river to its source; thence by the summit of the range to Maungapohatu Trig. Station; thence by a right line running in the direction of Puketapu Trig. Station to its intersection with the Ruakituri River in Block VII, Tuahu Survey District; thence by that river to the northern boundary of Small Grazing-run 84; thence by the northern boundary of that run and the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 1, Block VIII, Tuahu Survey District, to the Gisborne-Waikaremoana Road; thence by a line to and along the middle of that road to Bushy Knoll Road; thence by a line along the middle of the last-mentioned road to the northernmost corner of Section 2, Block IX, Hangaroa Survey District; thence by the eastern boundary of Section No. 1, Block IX aforesaid, to its south-eastern corner; thence by the eastern boundaries of Sections 3 and 4, Block IX aforesaid; thence by part of the northern and eastern boundaries of Tauwharetoi 4B Block, and the eastern boundary of Tauwharetoi 3A Block, to the southernmost corner of Tauwharetoi 3A Block; thence by the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned block to the Hangaroa River; thence by a line to and along the middle of that river to its confluence with the Ruakituri River; thence by a right line to the sea at Paritu; thence by high-water mark of the sea to the most southern point of Mahia Peninsula; thence towards the south generally by the high-water mark of Hawke's Bay to Moehangiangi; thence by the leading spur and the southern watershed of the Waikare River to the summit of Taraponui Mountain; thence by the leading spur to the confluence of the Mohaka River and the Waipunga River; thence by a right line to Tatarakina Mountain; thence by the eastern watershed of the Mokomokonui Stream to the summit of Pohokura Mountain; thence by a right line running due east to Pukahunui Stream or Hautapu River; thence by the leading spur and the western watershed of Te Hoe River to Maungataniwha Trig. Station in Tuatawhata Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary of Heruiwi No. 4 Block to its intersection with a right line running from the northernmost point of Lake Waikaremoana through a point 180 chains due north of Maungataniwha Trig. Station; thence by that line to the Taupo-Napier Road; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of Whararoto No. 8 Subdivision B Block; thence to and by the middle of Taharua and Mohaka Rivers to a point in line with a line running between Trig. Stations 68A and 65A; thence to and by that line to Trig. Station 65A aforesaid; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 26, Tawaki Tohunga, in Block XII, Mangamaire Survey District; thence by a right line in a south-westerly direction to Trig. Station 27; thence westerly by a right line to Trig. Station 28, Manukaiapu; thence by a right line to Ruapehu Trig. Station; thence towards the west generally by a right line to Paretaitonga Trig. Station, and by a right line to Ngauruhoe Trig. Station; thence by a right line to Tongariro Trig. Station; thence by a right line running in the direction of the mouth of the Waihi Stream to its intersection with the middle-line of the Wanganui River; thence by the middle of that river and the middle of the Ongarue River to the source of the last-mentioned river; thence by a right line to the Rangitoto Mountain; thence by a right line to the Puwhenua Trig. Station, the place of commencement.
