Revoking Order in Council licensing the Upper Waikawa Sawmilling Company (Limited) to use and occupy Part of the Foreshore and Land below Low-water Mark of the Waikawa River as a Site for a Wharf.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this fourteenth day of January, 1918.

Present :

THE HONOURABLE SIR JAMES ALLEN, K.C.B., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the seventh day of September, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 70, of the tenth day of the same month, His Excellency the Governor-General in Council did, in pursuance of the provisions of the Harbours Act, 1908, license the Upper Waikawa Sawmilling Company (Limited) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and land below low-water mark of the Waikawa River in order to maintain thereon a wharf erected in accordance with plan marked M.D. 3231, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, and upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth:

And whereas the company desire that the said license be revoked:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the Harbours Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke and determine the said recited Order in Council of the seventh day of September, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and the rights and privileges thereby conferred.
